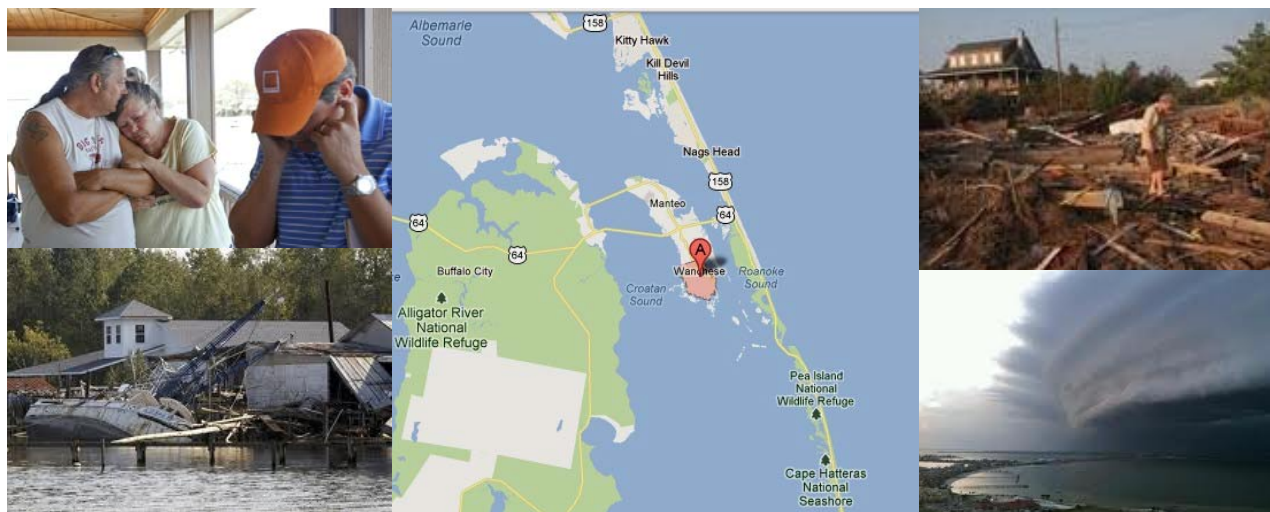


WANCHESE MISSION

FEBRUARY 23-26, 2012



A PRESBYTERY OF CHARLOTTE WORK TRIP AIDING THE POST-HURRICANE OUTER BANKS

Leaving Thursday, February 23 and returning Sunday, February 26, this weekend mission trip sponsored by the Global Mission Disaster Response Team will work with United Methodist Disaster Relief (UMCOR) to aid in restoring the fishing village of Wanchese-hard hit by Hurricane Irene.

Travel: Leaving the Charlotte Presbytery parking lot 9AM Thursday morning the team will travel six hours to Bethany United Methodist Church in Wanchese. Our accommodations are in nearby Nags Head at the Comfort Inn South Oceanfront. After two full work days Friday and Saturday we return Sunday following morning worship, arriving in Charlotte about 6-7PM.



Work: most is found in the rebuilding stage-sheet rocking, HVAC, electrical, roof and ceiling, floors, siding and fencing. There is also some home gutting and lighter work such as volunteering in the UMCOR disaster warehouse.

Additional requirements: **The cost for this trip is \$75/person** which includes hotel, 3 breakfasts and 2 lunches. The Presbytery will cover all transportation expenses. You must be age 15 or older and have completed the volunteer forms packet. Appropriate work clothes, gloves, tool belt/apron are suggested.

There will be a short planning meeting at the Presbytery office Monday, Feb 13-6PM.
