

## Formulary for Haiti

Ranitidine or famotidine 20 mgs	Augmentin 850mg
Bacitracin ointment	Cephlexin 500mg
Scabies solution	Lisinopril
Tylenol 325 mg	Advil 200mg
Amoxicillin 250mg	Cipro 500mg
Mebendazole 100mg	Hydrochloroquin 200mg
Chlorpheniramine 4 mg	
Atenolol or Lisinopril 5 mg	
(recommended to take a higher dose Atenolol 50-100mg and Lisinopril 20 mg)	
HCTZ 25 mg	
Metformin 1000mg	
Childrens chewable vitamins	
Multivitamins w/iron	
Prenatal vitamins	
Albuterol inhaler solution	

Quantities suggestions.

For a 3 provider team, most of the items quantity of 1000.

For vitamins, a 3 provider team used at least 10,000 to provide patients with enough for 1-2 months.

Assume a high incidence of high blood pressure and diabetes – double the rate you would see in the U.S.

Assume 40-50 patients/provider/day.

Standard supplies to take include bandaids, OTC anti-fungal creams, guaze wraps and ace bandages. Ob/gyn providers should also bring speculum and other unique ob/gyn supplies.
