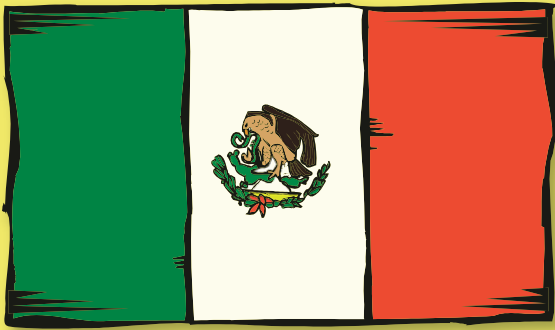


You can participate in global mission work even without a passport!

There are many students who want to attend but do not have the financial resources to do so.

There is land available at the Institute to raise some animals for income and to help feed the students, so pitch in here if you prefer.

Cow	\$500
Young female pig	\$70
Young turkey	\$10
Young chicken	\$1

The cows will have pasture to eat for the year and a half until they are ready to be sold, but medical treatment is a need at \$300 for all 5 cows they hope to have. Fencing needed is \$555.

Costs of feed for the others:

10 chicks	\$34 for the 2 ½ - 3 months to sale - total
10 piglets	\$119 for the 5 months to sale - total
30 turkeys	\$36 each for the 6 months to sale
