# 5 Cents-A-Meal

When you live in poverty, "good" economic times are often no better than bad times, and, when bad times come, those in poverty are the first to feel the effects. They lose employment during economic downturns and helping ministries experience cuts in funding *at the very time* the demands for service rise.

This year, we are seeing the need for aid in our communities increased *dramatically*.

The Hunger Action Work Group asks all congregations to join in this "fight against hunger" by conscientiously supporting the *5¢-A-Meal* program with 5¢ a meal, 15¢ a day, \$1.05 a week, and \$4.50 a month.
