- ***Self-Development of People*** helps empower economically poor, oppressed and disadvantaged people who are seeking to change the structures that perpetuate poverty, oppression and injustice. National grants are available, as well as local funding through the presbytery.
- ***Presbyterian Disaster Assistance*** cares for communities around the world wherever disaster strikes. PDA funds are received to respond to disaster needs nationally and internationally as disaster happens.
- ***Presbyterian Hunger Program*** works to alleviate hunger and its causes on a global basis, but also funds projects within our churches and presbytery.
