Participant Agreement

CAMP INFORMATION AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

When and Where?

The Middle School Retreat starts at 10:00am on Saturday, April 17, 2010 and ends at noon on Sunday, April 18, 2010 at Camp Pee Dee, a Presbyterian Camp near Bennettsville, SC (about 2 hours south on US 74, just southeast of Rockingham). For more information, visit www.camppeedee.org.

Meals

Lunch and supper on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday will be provided.

Who Should Come?

Middle School youth (grades 6-8) from the Presbytery of Charlotte and their adult leaders. NOTE: This is a spiritual experience. All activities are aimed at those individuals who are interested in growing in their faith and strengthening their spiritual ties.

Cost

\$40 per person (youth and adults). Participants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration must be received in the presbytery office by the firm deadline of April 5, 2010. Space is limited and fills quickly...early registration is encouraged.

What Goes On?

Keynote, worship, recreation, small-group discussions, music, prayer times, meeting new friends!

What to Bring

Sleeping bag or linens, pillow, towel, warm clothes, old clothes, Bible, toiletries, flashlight, water bottle. Camp Pee Dee is a rustic, outdoor setting in Bennettsville, SC. Lodging will be in cabins. Check weather report ahead of time and plan accordingly for inclement weather.

Please do not bring iPod, boombox, portable music players or portable games.

Adult Advisors

Each participant group must have at least one adult advisor registered for every six or fewer youth participants. Each group must include an adult of the gender of youth attending. The role of the adults will be to provide leadership and accountability for their group, fully participate in all activities, and provide support and feedback to event leaders. All adult leaders must complete the registration form and pay the fee.

How to Register

1. Make a copy of the registration form for each participant (youth and adult). Forms are also available online at www.presbyofcharlotte.org.
2. Payment should accompany registration. Cost is \$40 per participant (youth and adult). If payment is sent separately, it must be received by April 5, 2010. No spaces will be held without payment. Make checks payable to Presbytery of Charlotte. Church and individual checks or money orders are accepted. Please do not mail cash.
3. Check all forms for complete information, including emergency contact and parent signature before mailing. Incomplete forms will be returned.
4. Mail Registration forms and payments for your entire group together, if possible (see address at right). Registration is not complete without payment and full information, including signatures.

Leadership

This retreat is sponsored by the Youth Council of the Presbytery of Charlotte. Adult and youth members of the council will provide leadership along with Claire Lowrance & Neeley Lane, Youth directors at Covenant Presbyterian, Charlotte.

Cost is supplemented by churches in the Presbytery of Charlotte who participated in the Pentecost Offering. Proceeds for the Pentecost Offering support youth activities at the denominational, presbytery, and congregational levels.

PLEASE ASSIST US BY READING AND FOLLOWING THESE GUIDELINES:

Registration Deadline is firm: April 5, 2010. Space is limited and likely to fill quickly.

Registration by phone, fax or email cannot be accepted. Fax transmissions are unreliable and often not legible, please do not send faxes.

Payment must accompany registration form in order to reserve space. Individual payments are accepted or send one check for your entire group, payable to Presbytery of Charlotte.

Adults accompanying youth must also complete the registration form and pay the fee. The fee covers lodging and meals in addition to programming costs. The registration form provides emergency contact information in addition to assisting with placement for lodging, meal planning and programming.

Please note the ratio of one adult per six youth participants is required. One adult of each gender of youth attending is also required. If male and female youth are attending, both male and female advisors must also attend.

Emergency Information/Covenants: Please make sure: all emergency phone, health and insurance information is completed; youth and parent have read and signed the covenant agreements. This information is required for the safety and enjoyment of all participants!
