Grant Name	Who is Eligible	Nature of grant	Amount
Shared Missions Grant	Any 2-3 churches working together in mission, at least one church must have <125 members on the roll.	To support churches working together in mission. These are one time grants, not recurring.	<\$5,000
Hamilton Fund Grant	Any church under <200 members on the rolls. Priority is given to churches who financially support the Presbytery.	To support projects that small churches may not otherwise be able to include in budget. These are one time grants, not recurring.	<\$500
New Initiatives Grant	New Worshipping communities or established churches taking on a completely new initiative	To encourage and support congregations who are responding to changing ministry contexts by taking on new initiatives.	<\$2,500
Training, Workshops, and Coaching	Pastors, Session, Musicians	To support individuals or designated groups in the process of change or transformation.	<\$2,500, average \$750
New Worshipping Community Grants	New Worshipping Communities	To help foster new worshipping communities throughout the Presbytery.	<p>Level 1: \$7,500 “seed grant” from the PCUSA</p> <p>Level 2: \$25,000 “investment grant” from PCUSA; matched by MRC</p> <p>Level 3: \$25,000 “growth grant” from PCUSA; matched by MRC</p> <p>Level 4: Amounts determined in conversation with the MRC</p>
Transformation Grants (amounts of leveled grants determined in conversation with MRC)	Any congregation willing to engage in significant transformation.	To seek substantial new health, life, and ministry among congregations of the Presbytery.
