

DAVIDSON COLLEGE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (DCPC)

POSITION TITLE: Temporary Associate Pastor for Campus Ministry

CLASSIFICATION: Professional Staff, Full-Time 10 months a year, Contract, Salaried, Exempt

Job Overview

Davidson College Presbyterian Church (DCPC) is seeking an Interim/Temporary Associate Pastor for Campus Ministry. This Associate Pastor will be responsible, in partnership with student and congregational leaders, for leading DCPC's ministry to Davidson College students as well as faculty and staff where appropriate.

Qualifications

Ideally this staff member would have a Master's of Divinity (M.Div.) degree, be ordained or ordainable in the Presbyterian Church (USA), United Church of Christ (UCC), or the Reformed Church in America (RCA) and have experience in campus ministry.

Duties and Responsibilities

Engage with students in UKirk Fellowship (weekly while students on campus), Bible study (weekly with students and college staff), and other activities, some of which occur off-campus (e.g. fall retreat) and many of which occur in the evening or on weekends (e.g. meeting students for coffee or attending events in which the students perform or lead);

Assist students in connecting with the ministries of DCPC;

Work with the Davidson College Chaplain and establish relationships with campus representatives from other denominations/faiths on campus;

Participate in DCPC worship services on a regular basis (at least twice a month), including planning worship weekly with the worship staff and preaching at least once per semester;

Work in collaboration with the Campus Ministry Committee to enable DCPC members to connect to and support campus ministries and UKirk participants;

Interpret the ministries of UKirk to the DCPC congregation through events, staff meetings, committee work; etc.

Support other ministries of DCPC as appropriate and when able, such as leading adult faith formation classes or assisting with officer education.

This position reports to the Associate Pastor for Discipleship.

Compensation

In addition to a salary, DCPC offers major medical coverage through the PCUSA Affiliated Benefits Program (Board of Pensions) and retirement benefits through the PCUSA 403(b) program.
