



## MRC AMBASSADORS

MRC Ambassadors began last year during the pandemic, and really shined as an opportunity for fellowship, relationships, and partnerships between the congregations of Charlotte Presbytery. MRC is excited about MRC Ambassadors and the fruit it has already yielded, and we hope your church will choose to participate. Here is how it works:

- Sessions are invited to select at least one and up to two people from the congregation to serve as MRC Ambassadors. They may be ruling elders, but do not have to be. An ambassador can be any church member who has a hand on the “pulse” of the congregation.
- Ideally, ambassadors are those who are familiar with and willing to share about the life and ministry of their congregation and eager to listen to what God is up to in other congregations in effort to build mutually beneficial relationships with those churches.
- MRC Ambassadors from each geographical cluster will meet *quarterly* with an aim towards cultivating “cluster community” through fellowship and informative story sharing. There is no preparation, or work to do after the meetings other than sharing what God is up to in congregations throughout Charlotte Presbytery! Meetings will be virtual and may be in-person when it is safe to gather again.
- MRC Ambassadors commit to a one-year term. At the end of the year, Sessions may reappoint the same Ambassadors or appoint new Ambassadors.
- Clerks of Session are invited to submit to MRC the names, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses of the person(s) chosen by Session to serve as Ambassadors for your church.
